He worked with the Ministry of Trade and Industry in the Government of Burundi for 3 years from 2005 to 2007 as an Economist as part of the ODI Fellowship Programme; and concurrently as an Economic Consultant for Imani Development and Lecturer in Economic Policy, Université de Lumière, Bujumbura, Burundi. In addition, after his graduation from Trinity College Mr. Magee has worked as Economist for the Commission for Aviation Regulation, Dublin (August 2003 – December 2003).

Mr. Magee earned his Bachelor degree in Economics from Trinity College Dublin, Ireland (1999-2003) with first class honors. He also has a Master degree in Economics from London School of Economics, United Kingdom (2004-2005) with distinction.
