



## ZHANG Li

Zhang Li is Dean and Professor of Architecture in the School of Architecture, and Vice Principal of Architecture Design and Research Institute (THADI) in Tsinghua University, the PRC. He founded the award-winning design laboratory TeamMinus in THADI. In late 2021, he was elected to the Hall of National Masters in Survey, Engineering and Design.

Zhang Li is currently a Council Member (Region IV) of UIA, a standing board member of the Architectural Society of China, and the Editor-in-Chief of the leading Chinese magazine World Architecture.

Zhang Li's is the founder and a main advocator of urban ergonomics, an interdisciplinary domain focusing on human body and space, and the design of active urban spaces.

Zhang Li's design works cover a wide range of scales, from urban designs, buildings to microcosm interventions. He and TeamMinus has won over thirty national and international awards in the past decade. He is currently the Architect-in-Chief of Zhangjiakou Zone, and Shougang Big Air, both for the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics. He was the curator of the China Pavilion in the 2021 Venice Biennale of Architecture.
