 improve and widen approximately 12.8 km of existing bypass road connecting Kep town to Angkol Village and Provincial Road 1332

#### c) Koh Tonsay Passenger Pier Improvement Subproject

construct a pier complete with sanitation, water supply and power plant/transmission systems




#### Location of Kep Province and Subprojects
