

(1) Curriculum for Basic Workshop

The duration of the workshop is 2 weeks (10 working days), consisting of 84 teaching hours. The schedule includes a half-day opening ceremony and orientation (4 teaching hours), followed by 20 half-day specialised teachings (80 teaching hours). Within the specialised teachings, 56 hours will be conducted in a classroom setting (70%), and 24 hours will be provided through on-site teaching (30%). Morning classes will run from 8:30-11:30, afternoon classes will run from 13:30-16:30, and evening classes will run from 18:30-20:30 daily.
